Call for Applications: Health and Social Services Bursary Program

It is with pleasure that the English Community Organization of Lanaudière announces the launch of the McGill Bursary Program as part of the Health Professional Training and Retention Project.

The bursary program is intended to provide financial incentive to students from selected Quebec regions with appropriate English and French language skills pursuing full-time studies in the area of health and social services in a government recognized educational institution. Students from Lanaudière who are awarded bursaries must commit to staying in the region following the successful completion of their studies to work for a minimum of one year in a public health and social services institution or related organization

The Training and Retention of Health Professionals Project aims to improve access to safe and equitable health care and social services for English-speaking clients.

The program allows ECOL to promote this initiative in their community and to support students whose career project is to work in the field of health and social services.

The amounts of the scholarships for the year 2021-2022 are:

University level: up to \$ 10,000 CÉGEP / Collège: up to \$ 5,000 Vocational School: up to \$2,000

All applications must be submitted to ECOL no later than May 7th, 2021.
